**The clothes are adorable. Why did you decide to do the line?**

I've always loved children's clothes—my grandmother actually owned a children's boutique in La Jolla, CA, for 30 years. I grew up visiting her and working in her store, and then my mom and I had a children's boutique together for five or six years. I did all the buying for the store, and I really miss it. I stopped before I even had kids.

I remember when I first found out I was having a boy, I became obsessed with buying boys' clothes. Then came my daughter, and I was obsessed with buying girls' clothes. Everything looks 10 million times cuter when it's teeny-tiny. It's just so much fun! And there are only a few years when you can have fun dressing your kids however you want, which is why we included whimsical and trendy pieces. But at the same time, we use soft, non-scratchy fabrics, so the clothes are also practical.

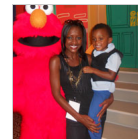

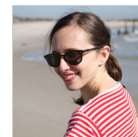
